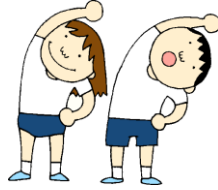

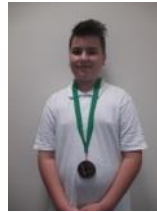
Superstar Corner
