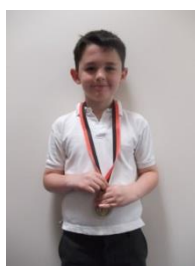
Superstar Corner

Oscar competed in two races and came 1st place with Westgate Leisure Centre and received 2 medals



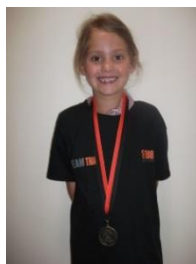
Gabrielle – Orchard Class
