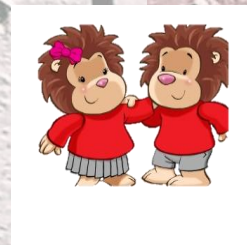


Summer 2 - Year 1

We are reading...

As readers we will be sharing a range of quality texts linked to our Learning Quests. We will be developing comprehension skills by having in depth discussions about the text and practising inference skills using evidence from the texts.



As writers we will be developing our writing skills with daily handwriting practise to improve letter formation. We will also be learning to consistently include the non-negotiables of capital letters, finger spaces and full stops in all of our written work as well as including adjectives and conjunctions to make our writing more interesting.



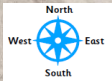
As mathematicians we will build on previous learning and explore place value within 100. We will introduce time, looking at hours minutes and seconds and learning to read o'clock and half past. We will learn to recognise notes and coins as well as how to count in coins.

As scientists we will be considering how to care for the planet, learning about simple ways to protect nature and be more sustainable. We will also build on previous learning about seasonal changes, observing how plants, animals and weather change with the seasons. Throughout we will continue to develop skills in working scientifically with practical investigations and observations



Geography

In Geography we will be locating oceans and continents. We will learn about British seas and beaches, then develop our field work skills on our trip to East Wittering Beach in July. After that we will compare the beach to one from another country and finally revisit compass points on a map.
