## English

We are starting English this term with a short film called *Girl and Robot*. We will be using this to create an instruction and a diary entry exploring the different emotions experienced over a period of time.

We will finish of the term with a text called 'Tuesday'. In this unit we will explore a recount and narrative. Additionally, we will be creating limericks in our poetry topic.

## Maths

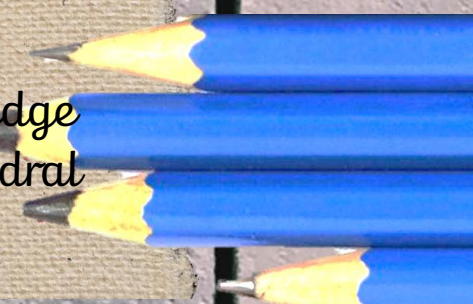
This half term we will begin our learning on time before revisiting our shape learning. In time we will be telling the time to 5 minutes and to the minute. We will also explore digital clocks as well as hours, seconds as well as months and years. Following this learning, we will revisit shape from Year 2 by looking 2D and 3D shapes before then looking at different angles.

## DT

Our until in DT this half term will be structures. Within this topic we will be exploring features of castles and cathedrals as well as nets and structures. We will use this knowledge to design and build our own cathedral and castle structures.

## Quest

This half term our quest is the 'Plants, and Patterns and Paint'. We will kick this quest off with looking at different parts of plant and carrying out a plant dissection. We will then explore the work of Claude Monet before creating our own 'Waterlilies' artwork. Our final quest of the year will be 'Chichester vs. Rome'. During this topic we will be exploring the geography of Roma and Chichester as well as doing a local walk to the Roman wall.



## Art

In art this term we will be taking inspiration from Claude Monet. We will take a close look at his work focusing on 'Waterlillies'. We will take this practice blending with watercolour before having a go at creating our very own Waterlillies piece.

## RE

We are returning to our exploration of Sanatana Dharma – a self-identified name for Hinduism. Our big question centres around: What is the best way for a Sanatani to lead a good life? We'll explore the belief in the deities and how they might worship them. We will be focusing on their belief in Karma and how their actions may impact other aspects of their later life.

We will continue our Ukulele learning this term with Mrs Gray!



## Computing

Data and information – branching databases

We will explore yes and no questions before looking at making groups. We will build on our knowledge to eventually use a branching database and present information.

## PSHCE

PSHCE will focus on 'Changing me'. This unit looks at how we grow and change over time. We will share that babies grow in the uterus where it gets nutrients. We will then look at how male and female bodies change on the outside and inside using vocabulary like *breasts, vagina, ovaries, egg, testicles, penis, sperm and puberty*.

## PE

We will be doing OAA (outdoor adventurous activities) where the children will be developing problem solving skills through a range of challenges.
