Maths

Our final half term in Year 6 will include themed projects, consolidation and problem solving.

The main project will be applying maths skills to a Year 6 bakery which will culminate in us making cupcakes. We will also explore the creative side of Maths and how it can be applied to art.

Art

The emblem of the Tudors is the rose and Shakespeare lived through the reign of the last Tudor monarch, Elizabeth I. Keeping with the rose theme, we will learn about the ceramic artist, Vanessa Hogge, who creates flowers from clay. We will then make our own flower pottery.



Science

In Science, we will be continuing to focus on the human body by investigating the effect drugs & cigarettes have on it. We will also be doing themed projects to ensure we are ready for secondary school Science.



History

Our final History unit is, 'Why was Shakespeare so Influential?'

We will be learning about:

- The historical period in which Shakespeare lived;
- William Shakespeare's life;
- Theatres in the sixteenth and early seventeenth century with a focus on the Globe theatre;
- The legacy of Shakespeare today.

DT

This term's Design & Technology unit is 'Come Dine with Me'.

The children will be planning and cooking for a Year 6 collaborative dinner. It will be a three-course dinner and use skills such as: chopping vegetables; slicing apples; rubbing in to make pastry; kneading dough; grating and weighing a variety of ingredients.

Music

This term's Music is linked to our Leavers' assembly. We will be practising our songs, learning lyrics and improving our performing skills.
