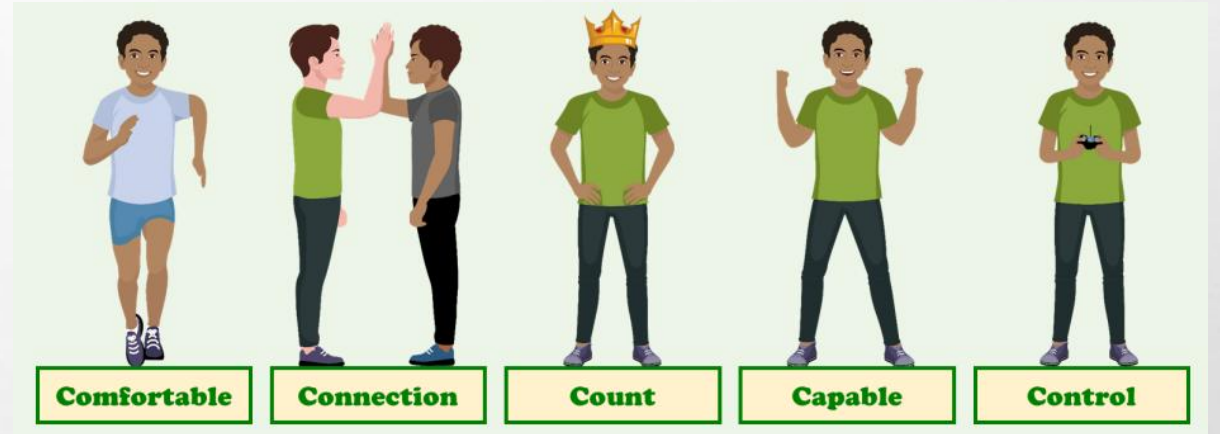

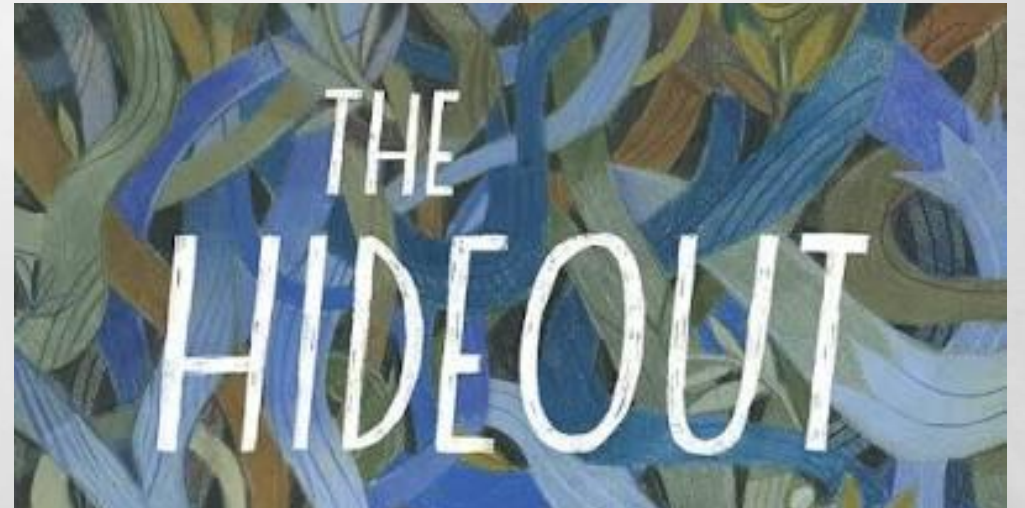

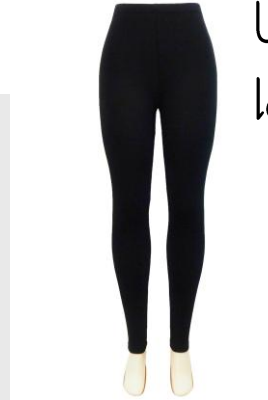

HOMEWORK EXPECTATIONS

New policy! (As a result of surveys..)

- **Daily reading:** pupils should read independently, ideally, each day but a minimum of 5 times a week, exploring a mix of genres. Texts will provide an appropriate level of challenge to ensure continued progress.
- **Developing comprehension skills:** children will be required to write a few details about what they have read in their reading record. This expectation will increase in depth and detail as they progress through the school, helping to develop their ability to understand, analyse, and discuss texts effectively.
- **Times tables practice:** regular practice of times tables through TTRS for 5 mins at least 5 times a week. This will help develop speed and accuracy in multiplication and division. This can be done through TT rockstars.

In addition to the above, there may be occasional opportunities for creative tasks to be completed at home to support the learning in the classroom. It will be an opportunity for children to deepen their knowledge and understanding or further explore an area of interest. It could also be to source a costume for a dress up day or production. All the tasks that would be set in this way would require no more than recycled materials from home.
