



Improving Punctuality

A number of children are coming into school late which is impacting their learning and the learning of others.

Our gates open at 8:40am and all children need to be in school by 8:50am.

At the beginning of the day, the children participate in linked provision activities from the minute they walk in. If your child is late and arriving at school at 9am, they are missing out on almost 20 minutes of learning time a day. This is 100 minutes a week which is a huge amount of time over the term.

Let's all make a special effort to ensure that our children arrive at school on time. This will help everyone have a more productive and positive start to their day.
