Dear Parent / Carer,

We are delighted that this term we will be able to offer a whole range of extra-curricular clubs again with some brand new clubs appearing for the first time!

ALL TEACHER LED CLUBS THIS TERM RUN FROM THE WEEK COMMENCING 18<sup>TH</sup> SEPTEMBER AND END ON THE WEEK COMMENCING DECEMBER 4th. NO CLUBS WILL RUN DURING HALF TERM BREAK (23<sup>rd</sup> TO 27<sup>th</sup> OCTOBER).

We are extremely grateful to our staff who give up their own time to run clubs on a voluntary basis. Places in clubs are limited due to health & safety issues with adult-pupil ratio and/or to ensure the club runs effectively with the resources we are provided with (eg. Dance club with 50 children is not feasible). Equally, some clubs are restricted for specific Year groups, in order to ensure that the delivery is appropriate for the age group.

We do continually strive to ensure that we have a wide range of clubs to meet children's demands with the time and resources we have available and, although we cannot offer all clubs to all Year groups, during their seven years at Parklands, children will have an opportunity to join different clubs when they are in an older Year group.

As far as possible, please ensure that your children attend these clubs on a full time basis and for the majority of the sessions. We understand that at times this is not possible and on these occasions we would be grateful if you could let the teacher leading the club know in advance.

















This term, we are taking **ONLINE BOOKINGS ONLY** for teacher led clubs. We hope that this will make the process of booking clubs easier for parents/carers as you will be able to simply login to your *Parentmail* account and click on your selection!

Spaces for each club are limited and will be <u>allocated by the system</u> on a <u>first come</u>, <u>first served</u> <u>basis</u> much the same way that Parent's Evenings slots are allocated. To access the list of clubs:

- 1. Login to your Parentmail account
- 2. Go to the 'PAYMENTS' tab
- 3. Click on the 'SHOP' item at the bottom of the screen
- 4. Click on the club option that you would like to select. Parents will only be able to see the clubs that are available for their child's year group. Select a child from the drop down menu if more than one of your children are eligible to attend.
- 5. Click 'ADD TO BASKET' (Note there is no charge for these clubs and the amount due is £0.00)
- 6. Once you have selected your club, click on 'PAY NOW' (\*Remember that you will not be asked to pay)
- 7. In the basket area, there is a 'PARENTAL CONSENT' heading. Please slide this toggle to indicate that you consent to your child attending the club selected.

Online club bookings will open at <u>7.00PM on Friday 15<sup>th</sup> SEPTEMBER 2023 AND WILL CLOSE AT</u> **8.00am ON MONDAY**.

<u>PLEASE ONLY CHOSE ONE CLUB PER CHILD.</u> If you have been able to book the club this is confirmation your child has a place. For the morning football clubs and craft club where there is a fee to pay we will send you a ParentMail payment notification next week.

A waiting list of those not successful in securing a place will be generated. If there is a lot of demand for one particular club, we may decide to offer children a place for approximately 4 weeks and then offer a further group of children chance to attend the club for the remaining weeks.

Please find attached a brief synopsis of each club to help your child choose the clubs they would like to attend.
