The Parents/Carers will:-

- Ensure that their child attends school throughout each school term, and arrives on time.
- Ensure that their child wears the correct school uniform and has a P.E kit in school.

- Inform the school if their child is absent by telephone on the first day of absence.
- Make the school aware of any concerns that might affect the child's work or behaviour as soon as they become apparent.

- Attend parents evenings about their child's progress and school information evenings.
