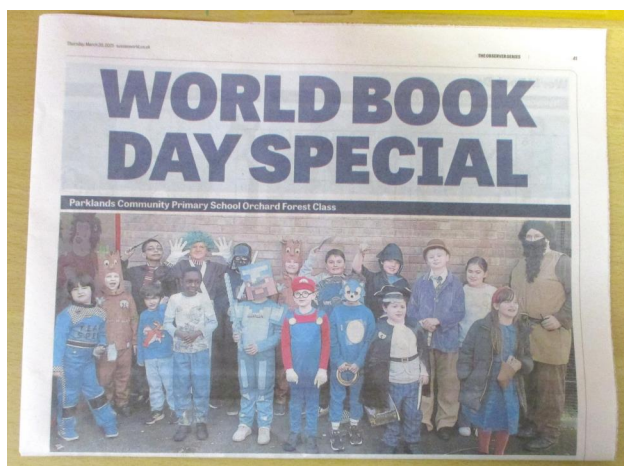




## SSC in the Chichester Observer
