

# Summer Two Year 3

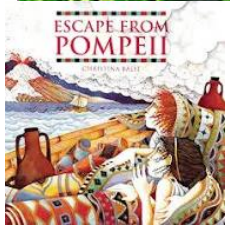


## English

## Maths

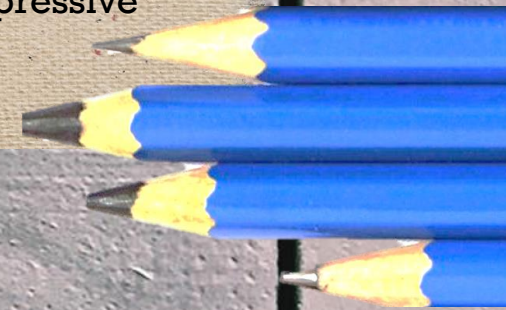

## Science

Using our enquiry questions as a stimulus: What did the Romans do for us? We will use the local area of Chichester to explore its local history during the Roman period and how it shaped the city. We will also have an exciting trip to Fishbourne Roman Palace where children will explore the mosaics, the house of the local Roman ruler and experience life as a Roman.

## RE

We are returning to our exploration of Sanatana Dharma – a self-identified name for Hinduism. Our big question centres around: What is the best way for a Sanatani to lead a good life? We'll explore the belief in how our actions may have consequences for ourselves and others. Children will learn about the Sanatani beliefs in Karma, Atman and Moksha and how they might live a good life through prayer and dedication to God.
