

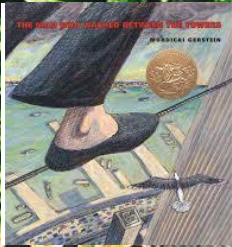
Summer Two Term Year 6

Maths

Our final half term in Year 6 will include themed projects, consolidation and problem solving.

The main project will be applying maths skills to a Year 6 bakery which will culminate in us making cupcakes to eat in our French Café. We will also explore the creative side of Maths and how it can be applied to art.

Art

The emblem of the Tudors is the rose and Shakespeare lived through the reign of the last Tudor monarch, Elizabeth I. Keeping with the rose theme, we will learn about the ceramic artist, Vanessa Hogge, who creates flowers from clay. We will then make our own flower pottery.



Science

In Science, we will be investigating Diet, Drugs & Lifestyle. Lessons will include:

History

Our final History unit is, 'Why was Shakespeare so Influential?'

We will be learning about:

- The historical period in which Shakespeare lived;

- Theatres in the sixteenth and early seventeenth century with a focus on the Globe theatre;
- The legacy of Shakespeare today.

Our second topic is a digital design unit called 'Navigating the World'. We will be consolidating our TinkerCad design skills to plan and build a navigational tool on the 3D platform.
