Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to announce that we are planning a trip to Tangmere Aviation Museum for all children in Year 6. With a key part of our Autumn Term One learning being based around World War Two, we believe the aviation museum will bring the children's learning to life.

This year, the classes will be mixed across the cohort in two groups – a Hurricane group led by Mrs Hill and a Spitfire group led by Mr Kenny. Hurricane group is visiting on Monday 29th September and Spitfire group will visit on Monday 13th October. The group lists will be available on SeeSaw.

We will travel by Stagecoach bus both ways; we will leave school at 8:40 am and then return back in time for the end of the school day. **In order to get the bus, we need to leave promptly from school at 8:40am and we ask children to be dropped at school between 8:20-30am for us to be ready to walk to the bus stop in Chichester centre. Please come to the front of school to be registered in the hall before we go.**

At the Museum, the children will take part in a wide range of activities learning about the importance of Tangmere during WWII. The children will need to bring a packed lunch, a drink (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please), a coat and wear school uniform. During the trip pupils will have the opportunity to visit the gift shop during the day (with a limit of £4.00 per child) if they wish.

We are asking for a parental voluntary contribution of £8.75 per child towards this trip. This covers the cost of transport, insurance, entry to the museum and a range of learning experiences for the pupils.

In order for the trips to go ahead, we really need some **parent volunteers** to come. Please see your class teacher, if you are able to join us.
