

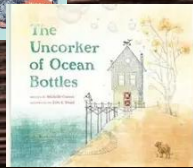
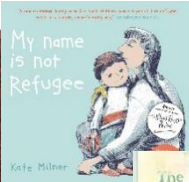
# Autumn Two in Year 3 - 'Discovering the UK' and 'More than Tinsel and Toys.'



## English

In English, we are using Kate Milner's 'My Name is not Refugee'. We will taking inspiration to write a diary entry focusing on using fronted adverbials, conjunctions and chronological order. We will also be reading 'The Uncorker of Ocean Bottles' by Michelle Cuevas to write job adverts and applications.

### We are reading...



RE: We will be delving into Christianity. During the second half of the term our central question will be 'Has Christmas lost its true meaning?' We will explore holidays, symbols, kindness, gift-giving and beliefs around Jesus.

## Maths

As mathematicians, we will be

- Using column method to add and subtract two numbers.
- Make exchanges crossing ones and tens using a column method.
- Add and subtract 2-digit numbers from 3-digit numbers.
- Use arrays and equal groups to multiply by 2, 5, 10 and 3.

## Science

As scientists, we will be exploring our diet. We will look at the five food groups and discover how they support a healthy body. This will continue to look at food waste and how we can be more sustainable.

## Art and DT

Linked to our science learning, we will be looking at cooking and nutrition in DT this half term. We will be exploring where food comes from and which foods are in 'season'. We will learn how to safely chop food items and will celebrate our learning by creating a seasonal food tart for King Charles.



## Please remember...

## PSHCE

In our Celebrating Differences unit, we will be exploring family, how we are all different, discussing conflict and resolution. We will also be exploring bullying, both physical and verbal. We will finish with how we give and receive compliments and know how this feels.

## Geography

As part of our topic we will consider the question 'Why do people settle?'

We will be exploring different types of settlements, mapping them, comparing historical and modern settlements. We will then explore the question 'What is special about the UK?' We will look at the different physical and human features of the UK.

## Computing

In Computing, the children will be looking at how digital devices work, what parts make a digital device, how digital devices help us and how we are connected to computers.

## Music

As musicians we are going to focus on sea shanties, beat, rhythm, chords, bass, dot notation in a unit of work.

This term, the focus will be on traditional folk songs.

There will also be plenty of Christmas singing practice.

## PE

During Indoor PE, we will be doing gymnastics. In this unit we will be balancing, rolling and jumping. Children will practice their sequence work and collaborating with others to create matching and contrasting shapes. Our outdoor PE unit is netball. In this unit the children will develop their understanding of the attacking and defending principles of the game.
