

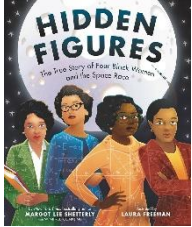
Spring Term one - Year 5

English

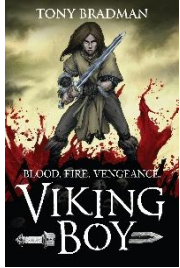
In English lessons we will start the term exploring the Hidden Figures involved in the Space Race

Maths

In maths we will be brushing up on our multiplication and division skills at the start of the term. Next, we will be briefly revisiting fractions which will then lead us on to working on decimals and percentages.

MFL

In our French lessons, we will continue to focus on learning how to communicate in simple sentences and phrases. We will be learning about the solar system, comparing the planets and exploring alien words in French!

Science



As Scientists, we will be

- * exploring the movement of the Earth and other planets, in our solar system, relative to the sun
- * describing the movement of the moon relative to the Earth.
- * learning to recognise the physical features of each planet – in particular that the Earth, moon and sun are approximately spherical.
- * developing an understanding of how the Earth's rotation causes day and night and makes the sun appear to move across the sky.



History

Over the next 6 weeks, we will be answering the big question... What struggle did England Face?

Each week we will learn more about what England was like before The Vikings invaded, what happened during the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the Kingdom of England and how England became a unified country.

We will complete a range of learning tasks to help us find out more about what life was like for a Viking living in Britain.

RE

Our enquiry question in RE will be How are sacred teachings and stories interpreted by Sikhs today?

Over the course of this unit we will explore the following concepts.

I can give an example of a story that teaches me how to behave towards other people

I can describe what a Sikh/non-Sikh might learn from a Sikh story and start to explain why stories can be important

I can recognise that stories can be an important way of expressing belief and meaning

I can explain how some stories can teach people about what is important and how to behave

Music

Music this half term is all about getting to know a song and where it comes from. We will practice all the elements of the song, bringing them together in a performance of the piece.

P5HCE

Our whole school focus for P5HCE next half term is Dreams and Goals.

In Year 5, we will be focussing on our future dreams.

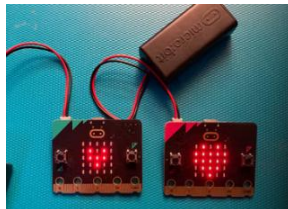
This will include sessions on
