School Uniform



Purpose of the School Uniform

The school uniform is an essential part of our learning environment. It promotes equality, supports student safety, and reinforces a sense of belonging within the school community. These guidelines outline expectations for parents and carers to ensure students arrive prepared for learning each day.

School Uniform

- Red sweatshirt, jumper or cardigan.
- Parklands Logo fleece
- White polo shirt.
- Grey trousers.
- Grey skirt.

- Grey pinafore dress.
- Grey shorts.
- Red and white checked summer dress in the summer term.

Shoes

- A pair of flat black plain/sensible shoes suitable for daily movement.
- Shoes that slip off the feet and open-toe sandals are **NOT** permitted.

PE Kit

- Parklands PE shirt OR plain collarless white t-shirt.
- Red shorts
- Optional plain black tracksuit for outdoor games.
- A change of shoes are needed for outdoor PE.

PE kit should be kept in a drawstring bag which is clearly named.

- Small drawstring or book bag

Outerwear

- Weather appropriate clothing - sun hats, rain coats or warm winter coats.

Children will be outside in all weathers.

Personal Appearance

- **Hair**

This should be neat, clean and kept away from the face.

Long hair must be tied up and hair bands should be in school colours.

- **Watches**

Children are allowed a small analogue or digital watch for telling the time only.

No SMART watches.

- **Jewellery**

No jewellery is allowed other than small stud earrings.

Please **provide tape** to cover earrings in PE or remove them in advance.

Nails

- Nails should be kept short, neat and clean.
- Nail extensions, gels or varnish are not permitted.

Non Uniform Items

- Hoodies or non-uniform jackets are not permitted to be worn inside the building.
- Leggings and coloured trainers/shoes are not permitted.

The Senior Leadership Team have the authority to grant deviations from the standard policy for specific, justified reasons.

If a student arrives without the correct uniform:

- Parents may be contacted to provide the missing item.
- The school may issue a temporary loan item where available.

Labelling

- All uniform items should be clearly labelled with the student's first and last name.

Please use name tapes or permanent marker pens.

Parents are encouraged to check labels regularly, especially after washing.

Support and Assistance

The school recognises that circumstances vary.

Last Friday Year 5 completed Level 1 Bikeability.

Bikeability Level 1 teaches you to:

Maintain your cycle: make sure your ride is in tip-top condition and make simple repairs.]

Glide: smooth, calm and collected.

Control your bike: including setting off, cruising, slowing down, braking and stopping.

These are great skills to master through the bikeability team no matter your child's previous cycling experience and the children loved sharing or bringing their bikes into school and learning together.
