

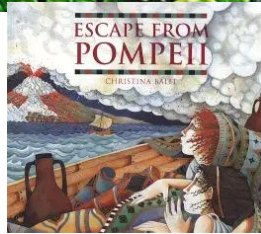
Summer One Year 3



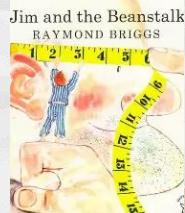
English

Maths

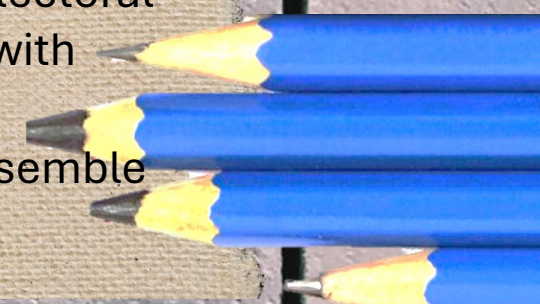
This half term we will conclude our learning on mass and capacity before revisiting our Fractions learning. In fractions we will be adding and subtracting fractions and finding fractions of a set number of objects and amounts. Following this learning, we will revisit Money from Year 2 by looking at pounds and pence before then converting them. We will then use this to help us add and subtract money.

Quest

This half term our quest is the 'Rotten Romans'. Our enquiry question is 'What did the Romans do for us?' In order to answer this question, we take a look at where the Romans came from alongside what life was like in Rome. We are also very excited to be taking a trip to Fishbourne Roman Palace where the children can get emersed in our topic!

DT

Our until in DT this half term will be electrical posters. We will be using circuits to create our very own electoral posters. The children will begin with topic research, then Design development before the final assemble of the electric poster



Art

In art this term we will be taking inspiration from our trip to Fishbourne Palace. We will take a close look at the Roman mosaics and their purpose. We will take this and compare them to a range of modern artists before having a go at creating our very own mosaics.

RE

We are returning to our exploration of Sanatana Dharma – a self-identified name for Hinduism. Our big question centres around: What do some deities tell Sanatanis about God? We'll explore the belief in the deities and their aspects of the one supreme being which is Brahman. There will be a focus on Ganesha and Lakshmi and what particular blessings they bestow.
